BOARD MINUTES: 10:01 AM Sept 9 2019 Called to order by President Dale Fye. Ken Christenson, Brian Edwards, John Neitzel, Issac Henning, April Campbell, Dale Fye and Jim Beeler present. Dale opened the meeting officially appointing Mike Linnell as replacement Board Member for Nick Huff; the secretary position remains unappointed to date. The board reviewed the land use agreement presented by Old Iron, Inc. to Branch 245. The board members discussed all line items on the agreement. Brian Edwards and John Neitzel recommended a change to the agreement to reduce the payback amount of the building, based on a thousand dollars a year or the building's income revenues to the club each year. Jim Beeler made a motion to reduce the amount of the building's payback amount based on the building's income revenue. Ken Christensen seconded his motion and Ken, Brian, John, Issaac and Jim voted infavor, Dale and April as representatives of Old Iron, Inc for the land use proposal did not cast a vote. It was agreed to discuss this with club members at the general meeting. Discussion insued about show name, show length moving forward and the treasurer's report was given in detail, it was moved to discuss and vote on these matters in open forum at the club meeting. John Neitzel presented information that their may be reimbersement available through the County's Hotel/Motel tax. He tendered his resignation as Vice President and expressed his desire for Justin Beutow to be considered. Adjourned at 10:34AM - minutes taken by April Campbell

**GENERAL MEETING MINUTES**: 11:11 AM Sept 9 2019 Meeting Called to Order by President Dale Fye and our Flag Salute was lead by appointed Board Member Mike Linnell. A moment of silence was held in rememberance of many friends; Rich Bergmann, Alice Corbin, Jim Murphy, Jim Smith, Curt and Eileen Warner and Dan Nicholas. Dale asked for the past minutes to be approved. He called for any old business; Dale thanked the members for their help putting on a great show and asked members to look at the October issue of Farm Collector Magazine; Justin Beutow stated the six page article about our show was great with lots of pictures. Dale then presented

the land use agreement to the club as modified by the Board. April read allowed The agreement with the the wording as follows: Land Use Agreement Old Iron, Inc. (landlord) agrees to sublet a portion of the Farm Property located at 11 E Johns Creek Drive, Shelton WA to Early Day Gas Engine and Tractor Association Branch 245 (EDGETA 245). The fee for this rental is defined as: the EDGETA 245 club members preparing the grounds for the club's use. Liability Insurance Shall be maintained by the club naming property owners as also insured. The defined grounds use space is subject to the parcel's south side 12 acres, less planted crop ground. Farm Property use for Branch 245 includes scheduled meetings, work parties and up to 3 club events a year as well as the construction of mutually agreed upon improvements to the grounds. This agreement shall commence on and continue through \_\_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_. This agreement shall be reviewed at the termination date stated above with the option of renewal each year according to the mutual desires of both parties. Request for renewal shall be communicated in writing and received 90 days prior to this agreement's expiration date. Old Iron, Inc. agrees to maintain all property taxes and insurance on the building(s) and has authorized use of the building(s) when they are not in use by EDGETA 245. EDGETA 245 has the right to hold events, meetings and work parties at the Farm Property with use dates being approved by Old Iron, Inc. Structure A known as the Branch 245 Building and any other improvements shall become the sole property of the landlord if the club disbands, nullifies this land use agreement or fails to use the Farm Property for two consecutive years. If the landlord nullifies the land use agreement the club will be reimbursed their cost of Structure A, \$11000 less the income produced yearly from the rental of the building received by the club from club events. As representative of Old Iron, Inc. (landlord) April asked every club member in attendance their input on the agreement with many positive comments, nods and thumbs up and one member asked if we considered having an attorney look it over. April said no but she talked to with Dan Nicholas at the show and his recommendation was that the agreement should be put in the newsletter so all members have a chance to review it and vote at the next meeting. Dale then formally announced the resignation of members Nick and Judy Huff and John Neitzel. It was announced that Mike Linnell was appointed Board member until the next vote. Nominations were then opened for Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary and 2 Board Seats (Huff and Henning). April recommended Ed Cole as VP, Ed declined. Austin Lyons expressed interest in a position on the board or VP and John Neitzel recommended Justin Beutow for a position. (President Fye and Board seats Beeler, Edwards and Christensen open 10/2021) Dale mentioned help is needed for many of the things April does; a person to handle membership, a swap meet chairman and or a new newsletter editor would be wonderful. Discussion then took place to keep the Pioneer Power of the Pacific Northwest; voted and passed unanimously; duration of the show was discussed and Cindy Neitzel proposed two days; it was voted on and passed to be a three day show again. Apologies were given to Cindy. Swap Meet Dates were discussed and decided on April 25<sup>th</sup> 2019, Show Date July 10, 11 and 12 2019 and Swap Meet October 31st 2019. The Hotel/Motel tax reimbursement was mentioned and Dale said he will ask member Steve Gay to look into it. Randy King brought an engine to run, the Lyons boys brought out a case tractor to drive around for the day and Jeff Parker expressed that he will be bringing his new 100 HP Atlas to reside at the show grounds on display. Meeting was adjourned at 12:16pm and potluck followed. Cindy's 50/50 Raffle brought in \$45 - notes provided by Dale Fye and **Destiny Smith**


